PLEASE ENTER EARLY TO ALLOW TIME FOR MEMBERS TICKETS TO BE SENT TO EXHIBITORS

- a) It is compulsory that all livestock exhibitors be financial members of the MB A&H Society Inc.
- b) Cattle exhibitors must adhere to Johnes Guidelines as set by the MB A&H Society Inc.
- c) The minimum status required for exhibiting beef cattle at the MB A&H Society Inc. Show is J-Bas 6.
- d) Exhibitors must include their accreditation certificate number on the entry form.
- e) Beef exhibitors must complete the herd health status declaration and return with entry form(s).
- f) All cattle must have NLIS tags and the Show Society Inspectors reserve the right to inspect animals for breed specifications and may exclude any animal from the judging if it does not meet specifications.
- g) Exhibitors are requested to bring their vehicles through gate 3 and use the 'Beef Only' loading and unloading facilities.
- h) Exhibitors must be bona fide owners or be able to provide lease/transfer papers.
- i) All entrants to be named and stud identification stated on entry forms.
- j) All cattle are to be registered in their respective societies herd books, including appendices and comply with Breed Society requirements.
- k) Ages for the classes to be taken from the 1st of September 2017.
- l) All cattle in group classes must be shown in their respective individual class.
- m) It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that cattle are entered and shown in the correct class.

An exhibitors' meeting will be held following the completion of the judging to determine any modifications required for the following show. All exhibitors and interested members of the public are invited to attend.

No second prize money awarded unless three or more entries in the class.

Most Successful points are awarded as follows First 5 points, Second 3 points, Third 1 point.
In the event of a draw the winner will be decided by the amount of championship ribbons won

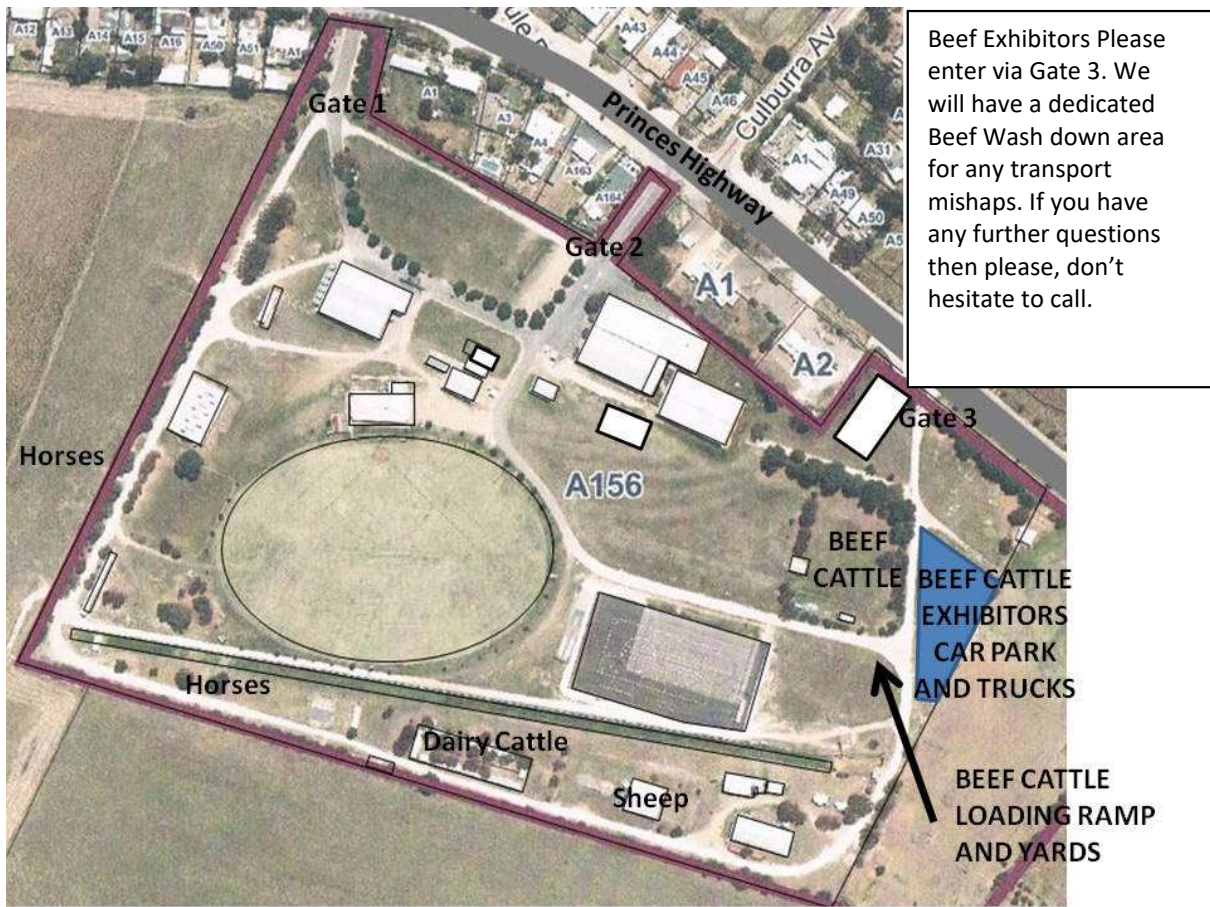

MEMBERSHIP
