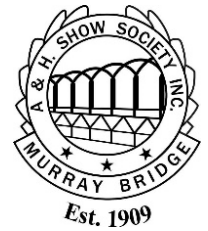

SCARECROW COMPETITION

RULES:

- **Entry forms for Scarecrows must be at the Show Office by no later than Friday, 20 September 2019.**
 - Scarecrow must be self-standing.
 - Scarecrows will be displayed in the open and need to be able to withstand the elements.
 - All exhibits must be accompanied by an exhibit ticket.
 - Scarecrow must be able to scare off birds by way of being upright and/or use of shiny materials and/or movement in the wind.
 - Scarecrow must not be taller than 1.7 meters
 - Entries will be judged on functionality, visual appeal and originality.
 - All exhibits are entered at own risk.
 - Novelty Scarecrow can resemble any character, shape or animal, but always remember the aim of the Scarecrow.
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- **Scarecrows must be delivered to the Showgrounds on Friday, 27 September before 5pm.**
