RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) All exhibitors must be members of the Murray Bridge A&H Society. Membership fee is \$20.
 - Each rider must be a member and will be issued with a wristband to be worn while competing.
 - Wristbands to be collected from the convenor's tent.
 - Each horse's name and riders name to be included on entry form
- 2) Protest to be in writing and accompanied by \$50 fee, to the Secretary within 20 minutes of the incident.
 - Fee refunded if protest upheld
- 3) Committee reserve the right to measure entries where height is specified
- 4) All competitors are to respect others' rights by ensuring that their exhibits are given adequate space. Please advise the Convenor if you have any concerns.
- 5) All competitors must wear correct riding attire. Helmets must comply with current standards and be less than 5 years from date of manufacture. Riders must wear approved boots with smooth soles and small heels. Handlers must wear suitable footwear that provides protection to the top of foot and toes.
- 6) Ages stipulated are the age of the rider on the day.
- 7) Exhibits must be under effective control by a capable handler/rider at all times.
- 8) The Exhibitor of any loose horse/pony may be liable for a fine up to \$200 at the Committee's discretion
- 9) No horses to be tethered to the fence
- 10) No Dogs are permitted on the oval/ car parking areas (show society ruling)
- 11) Events may be added, deleted or combined at the discretion /right of the HIA Committee
- 12) Horses are not to be lunged on the oval. A signed area will be available on the grounds.
- 13) Stable hire available \$15 /stable/day to be booked and paid with entries.
 - All stables will be inspected after the show.
 - i) *if unsatisfactory cleaning is recorded YOU will be invoiced a \$50 FINE*
- 14) Committee will consider refund on presentation of veterinary certificate
- 15) Camping is permitted on the grounds in designated areas
- 16) Horses are not to enter the Cattle areas due to animal health restrictions
- 17) The Society will not be held responsible for any accident that may be caused to, or by, any horse and it shall be a condition of entry that each nominator hold the Society blameless and shall indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such incident. No person shall be allowed in the ring during judging except the Judges, Stewards, Reporters, Secretaries and persons in charge of exhibits, unless invited by the President of the Society, or with the written consent of the Secretary or Convener.
- 18) Any person giving wrong description or giving annoyance to the Show Officials or Judges is liable to disqualification and may be barred from future shows.
 - Any act that, in the opinion of the Judges, Stewards or Convener, is deemed cruel or neglectful (e.g. whip marks) will cause the exhibitor to be barred from the class. Severe cases will be reported to appropriate authority
- 19) Competitors please note – Murray Bridge A & H Society encourages "SPIRIT OF FAIR PLAY"!
- 20) Horses to be shown as either a hack or a hunter - not both
- 21) All horses must walk in any area that is not a practice or competition arena and must obey directions from show appointed grounds people
- 22) If judging clashes, events will not be delayed. No refunds.
- 23) Led rider classes (excluding dedicated leading rein pony classes) are for riders that have not yet mastered riding on their own. If a rider enters a led rider class this prevents the same rider from then riding in any open competition off the lead for the rest of the show program.
- 24) The convenor reserves the right to refuse any entry without notice. No refunds on entries to be paid including on the day of competition.
- 25) All competitors compete absolutely at their own risk: having signed an Agricultural Soc Council Of South Aust Horse Sport Indemnity & Waiver.
- 26) Random swabbing may take place – please contact EA. re anti-doping policy and banned substances
- 27) UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES can any mare be shown at this show with a foal at foot, in foal is accepted however not with a foal at foot
- 28) HACK RINGS: ANY exhibitor competing in RINGS 1 & 4 are STRICTLY not eligible to compete in rings 3 & 4
 - The Exception to this are competitors in royal qualifier ring in the leading rein classes can also compete in topsy events
- 29) HACK RINGS 1 & 2 are affiliated with the Royal Agricultural & Horticultural Society and therefore are Royal Qualifying Events
- 30) PIC Number is COMPULSORY and MUST be on the entry form!

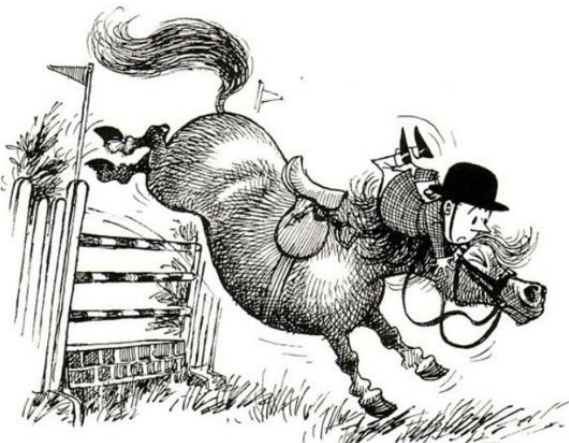

Section A - Supplier’s statements about risk and duty of care Agricultural Societies Council of South Australia and the Murray Bridge Agricultural & Horticultural Society (together the Suppliers) advise as set out below: The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt. Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers’ facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers’ facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of the Civil Liability Act 1936 SA. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers. This document acts as an exclusion of liability under the Civil Liability Act 1936 SA if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill. Section B - Participant’s acknowledgements By signing this document I acknowledge that: Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers’ facilities is a recreational activity for the purposes of the Civil Liability Act 1936 SA

1. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers’ facilities at my own risk.
2. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers’ facilities is a hazardous activity and involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me and others.

8. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
9. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers’ facilities.
10. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers’ facilities.
