JUDGING TO COMMENCE AT 9:00AM SHARP. SHEEP ENTERED IN THE SCHOOLS SECTION TO BE YARDED NO LATER THAN 8:30AM ON SATURDAY 25th SEPTEMBER 2021. EXHIBITS MAY BE YARDED ON THE NIGHT BEFORE. A YARD CLEANING FEE OF \$10 PER PEN WILL BE APPLIED TO ANY EXHIBITOR WHO LEAVES STRAW OR RUBBISH IN THEIR PENS.

Entry Fee: \$2/class unless otherwise stated

It is compulsory that all exhibitors be a financial member of the Murray Bridge A&H Society. Exhibitors must adhere to Johnes Guidelines as set by the Murray Bridge A&H Society. Sheep exhibited at the Murray Bridge Show must be free of lice, footrot, Ovine Brucellosis, Ovine Johnes and any other restricted sheep disease. All exhibitors must complete a NLIS Sheep Vendor Declaration and National Sheep Health Statement and provide a copy of your National Sheep Health Statement and NLIS Sheep Vendor Declaration to the show prior to unloading your animals into the Sheep exhibition area. The convenor reserves the right to inspect animals for breed specifications and may exclude any animal from the judging if it does not meet specifications. The Convenor reserves the right to move an exhibit to a different class if it has been inappropriately entered. Exhibitors are asked to bring their vehicles through gate 3. Exhibitors must be bona fide owners or be able to provide lease/transfer papers. All sheep in group classes must be shown in their respective individual class. Exhibitors must bring sheep out of pens for judging if requested (Commercial Entries exempted). All stud and commercial exhibits to be on grounds by 9:00am EXCEPT SCHOOL EXHIBITS SEE NOTE EARLIER. Judging to commence at 9am Saturday 25th September 2021. Sheep in the commercial classes may come from South Australian flocks that are not subject to any Animal Health Restriction. The Convenor reserves the right to split any class if they deem the numbers provide an opportunity for greater spectator enjoyment. The judge reserves the right to not apply any ribbons where he or she concludes that an exhibit is not of the standard required for the class they are in.

Prizes

No prize money will be paid however there is excellent sponsorship and there are great prizes and ribbons to be won. Only a first place ribbon will be awarded in classes of 3 or less exhibits, first and second ribbons will be awarded in classes with 4 or more exhibits and a third prize will be awarded if there are more than 6 exhibits in the class.

MOST SUCCESSFUL SHEEP EXHIBITOR

There will be a prize for the most successful sheep exhibitor at Murray Bridge Show - Aggregate points: First – 3 points, Second – 2, third – 1 and Championships 4 points

SECTION C – SHEEP - SCHOOLS COMPETITION

All sheep to be exhibited by a student from a South Australian School. All sheep must have been prepared by students from a South Australian School and must be at least Animal Health Score 6 or better. All animals will be weighed on the morning of exhibition at the showgrounds. Exhibitors must be able to provide date of birth and date of last shearing information. Where a sheep has been sampled by the SA Merino Association for the Royal Show Competition then please submit these fleece results with the entry. If they haven't been sampled, then let us know by 3rd September 2021 and we can organise this for you. This information will be recorded on a card which will be displayed by the handler whilst the animals are being exhibited in their respective classes. Judging to commence at 9am.

All class participation will result in points being awarded to the school and the school with the most points awarded throughout the competition wins the Perpetual Murraylands School Sheep Challenge Trophy and an annual keepsake trophy for this year. **CLASSES**

- 1 **Junior Handler Competition** – Open to anyone of any age who wishes to improve their exhibitor skills. **Entry is FREE** and nominations for this class will be accepted by the convenor or stewards up until 9am on the day of the show. It is up to the handler to arrange for a sheep to exhibit but if the convenor is notified of a need to find sheep, she will assist with negotiations with existing stud exhibitors to enable students without sheep to participate. In the event of three or more entries in this class the Convenor reserves the right to divide the competitors into more age specific divisions.
- 2 **Merino Ewe**, 18 months or under (2 tooth or under) - must be shown with at least 60mm of wool
- 3 **Merino Wether**, 18 months or under (2 tooth or under) - must be shown with at least 60mm of wool
- 4 **Maternal Breed Ewe**, 18 months or under (2 tooth or under), any maternal breed or suitable composite – must be shown with at least 60mm of wool
- 5 **Prime Lamb exhibiting all lambs teeth** – any breed or cross breed, exhibited unshorn as if being presented for sale as a sucker lamb for the **domestic trade**, may be crutched, trimmed or “bung holed” to remove any staining or dags.
- 6 **Prime Lamb exhibiting all lambs teeth** – any breed or cross breed, exhibited unshorn or shorn as if being presented for sale or slaughter for the **export trade**, may be crutched, trimmed or “bung holed” to remove any staining or dags.

Junior Judging – FREE ENTRY

Open to anyone of any age who wishes to improve their judging skills. **Entry is FREE and nominations for this class will be accepted by the convenor or stewards up until 10am on the day of the show.**

Competitors will review four fleeces or animals and must place these into first to fourth and record comments on these positions. Competitors may be asked to make an oral presentation on their positioning. In the event of three or more entries in this class the Convenor reserves the right to divide the competitors into more age specific divisions. This competition will commence with a presentation at 10:30am with the fleeces and animals being available to be reviewed from 10am- 12 noon. Oral presentations will commence at 12:30pm.

- 7 **Karoonda & Districts Merino & Poll Merino Association Junior Judging Merino** –Competitors will review four animals of the same gender and must place these animals first to fourth and record comments on these positions. Competitors may be asked to make an oral presentation on their positioning.
- 8 **Jon - Del Prime SAMM Junior Judging Maternal** –Competitors will review four animals of the same gender and must place these animals first to fourth and record comments on these positions. Competitors may be asked to make an oral presentation on their positioning.
- 9 **Keller Livestock Junior Judging Prime Breeds** –Competitors will review four animals of the same gender and must place these animals first to fourth and record comments on these positions. Competitors may be asked to make an oral presentation on their positioning.
- 10 **Rodwells Wool Junior Judging Wool** – **Competitors will review four fleeces of the same breed and must place these fleeces first to fourth and record comments on these positions. Competitors may be asked to make an oral presentation on their positioning.**

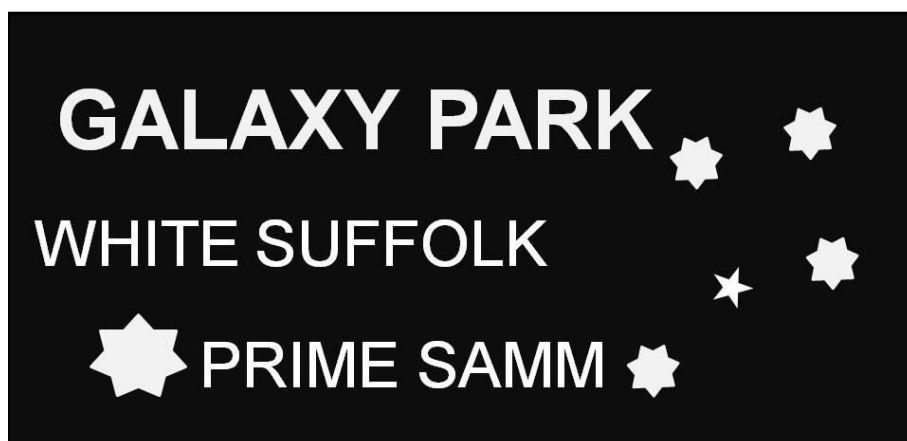

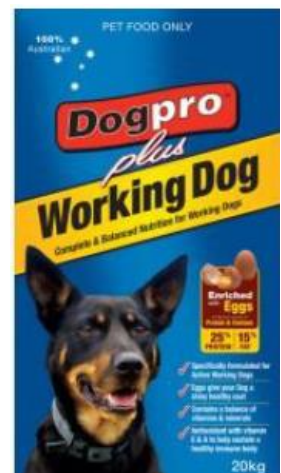

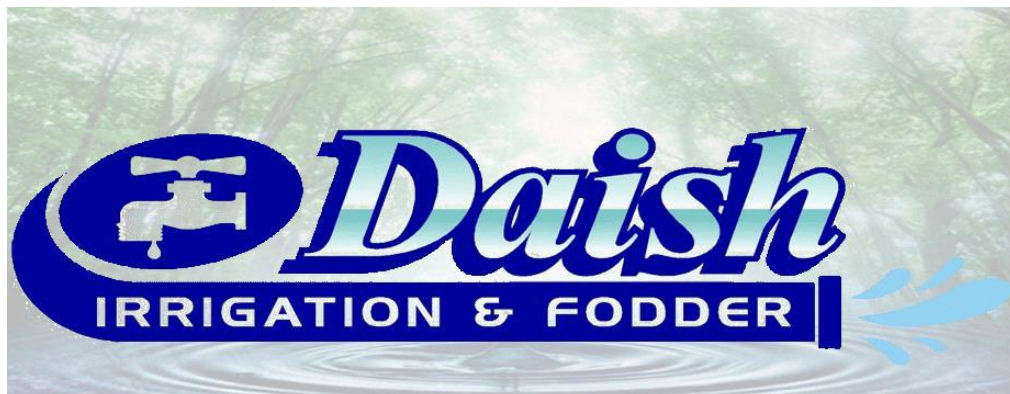
