- All exhibits to be delivered to the show office by 5pm Thursday 23 September 2021.
- All exhibits must be able to be opened for judging, with the exception of preserves.
- No wax on sauces or pickles, and all screw tops to be loosened before handing to convenor.
- All jams, marmalade, jellies, pickles to be in glass jars <u>250-500gms</u>.
- Jellies to be made from fresh fruit and fruit for preserving of current season and preserved in syrup.
- Please securely fix exhibitor ticket to jar/bottle with a rubber band don't stick to lid.
- AOV means Any Other Variety
- All exhibitors enter at their own risk. All care will be taken in the transit, storing, handling and displaying of the entries. Unfortunately, accidents may and do sometimes occur resulting in damage or loss. The Murray Bridge A&H Society Inc. staff, convenors, stewards, committee, judges and volunteers will not be held responsible or liable for any loss or damage to any entry which may occur.
- The section judges, convenors, committees or Murray Bridge A&H Society Inc. officials have the right to add, delete, combine or alter any of the advertised events if they feel it is for the betterment of the section.
- The Judge's decisions are final. NO correspondence or protest will be entered into regarding the results.
