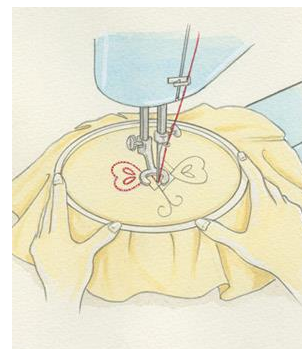

**Knitting & Crochet: blocking.**

**Make up & Presentation**

- Use flat seam
- Block by pinning to shape on padded surface. Spray with water and leave to dry OR
- Steam lightly by holding iron above the work without touching.
- Item should be left to completely dry and cool before removing pins and sewing in ends.
- If shaped, block before you put it together and lightly press seams.
