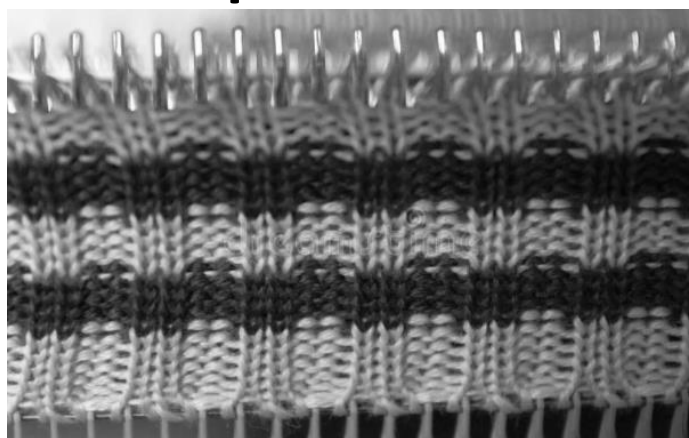

The section judges, convenors, committees, or Murray Bridge A&H Show Society Inc. official have the right to add, delete, combine or alter any of the advertised classes if they feel it is for the betterment of the section.

The judge's decisions are final. NO correspondence or protest will be entered into regarding the results.

The advertising of any items for sale or the displaying of business cards or other advertising material within the Mr. Ken Wells Pavilion is strictly prohibited by law.

The sale of goods at the show is available to those who purchase a trade site.

Following the close of the show on Saturday 25 September 2021 ALL entries and any prizes won MUST BE collected form the Mr Ken Wells Pavilion via the section convenor between 4pm and 5pm.

Exhibit cards and signatures will be required for the collection of entries and any prizes won.
